IS LIFTIQUE RIGHT FOR YOU?

The consideration of a Liftique Procedure depends on how your skin is aging, the level of your skin's sun damage, and your goals for anti-aging skin treatments. Most women in their late thirties or early forties, who see early skin laxity in the face, start by trying store purchased skin creams.

Ten years ago, skin tightening technology was in its infancy. Lasers were being used to resurface skin, smooth fine lines, and correct sun-damaged skin, but the recovery times were often long and unacceptable.

What medical researchers learned is that although lasers create smooth skin, lasers don't introduce the deep skin restructuring to the collagen matrix that provides the long-lasting, tightening, and firming results that patients seek.

Some current skin tightening devices use ultrasound energy, which is applied to the skin's surface (epidermis) to heat the deeper layers of skin (dermis). This is an attempt to reorganize the collagen and elastin fibers within the deep layers of the dermis.

Unfortunately, ultrasound-based skin tightening technology devices do not reliably focus enough energy to reach the deeper skin layers that create effective, long-lasting skin tightening results. In addition, these technologies can cause significant patient discomfort during the actual procedure.




WHAT IS THE LIFTIQUE PROCEDURE?

The Liftique Procedure is a radio frequency (FR) energy based skin tightening procedure based on clinically proven and FDA-approved technology.

Liftique uses advanced medical-quality technology for its exclusive procedure, developed by Dr. Robert Applebaum. The Liftique Procedure delivers highly focused energy safely and temporarily, leading to unmatched skin contraction. This deep treatment to the deep dermis of the skin, when combined with superficial treatments, can lead to patients seeing near face lift like results with a 35%^{1,2} to 50%^{3,4} tightening of the skin surface and reduction in wrinkles and fine lines.

The results from a Liftique Procedure are a lifted, firmer and naturally tighter look for your face, neck, jowls and chin.









The Science behind the Liftique Procedure.

The Liftique Procedure uses a combination of Radio Frequency (RF) Technology and treatment delivery methods. RF energy is used on the surface of the skin, and below the skin's epidermis to naturally stimulate collagen and elastin matrix growth from the inside out—in one procedure and with minimal recovery time.

The following illustration shows how the Liftique Procedure RF Technology, firms and tightens skin, by treating the deep layers of the skin where collagen and elastin can become depleted with age. After the procedure, new collagen growth and the realignment of existing collagen bundles ultimately lead to tight skin and a fresh look.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR SKIN TIGHTENING PROCEDURE

Your surgeon should provide you with specific pre-treatment instructions, answer all your questions, and request you have a pre-procedure exam to determine your overall health. In advance of the procedure, the surgeon should ask you to do the following:

- stop smoking for at least six weeks prior to treatment to promote healing
- avoid taking aspirin, certain anti-inflammatory drugs, and some herbal medications that can cause increased bleeding
- discontinue any topical skin products that might increase the risk of complications from treatment
- and stay fully hydrated before and after the surgery to ensure a safe recovery

What can you expect on the day of a skin tightening treatment?

Nonsurgical or minimally invasive skin tightening treatments are generally performed on an outpatient basis in an accredited freestanding office-based surgical suite or center. Your medical team will comprise your surgeon, an anesthesiologist, and a surgical nurse to ensure your comfort throughout the procedure.

High-quality nonsurgical or minimally invasive skin tightening procedures take at least 1 ½-2 hours or longer. Doctors will administer medications throughout the procedure for your comfort.

- Oral, local anesthesia, or intravenous sedation may be desirable in some instances. For your safety during the procedure, the surgical nurse will monitor your vital signs.
- The surgeon should follow the treatment plan that you both discussed.
- After the procedure is completed, you will be taken into a recovery area where you will be monitored and discharged home when you are ready.

Be sure to arrange for someone to drive you home after the treatment, as well as someone to stay with you for at least the first night following the procedure. Elite medical providers, such as Liftique Naturelle M.D., in Beverly Hills, offer their patients complimentary pick-up and take-home services as part of their Red Carpet patient experience.

What you can expect immediately after the procedure

When the anesthesia wears off, you may have some discomfort. If it's extreme or long-lasting, contact your physician immediately. Depending on the device the surgeon used, patients may experience skin reddening, swelling, and numbness at the treatment area(s). Although complications from nonsurgical or minimally invasive skin tightening procedures are infrequent, contact your surgeon to confirm if your symptoms are normal.
